1. To be eligible, you must be a high school senior attending Martinsville High School, a private school in Martinsville or a Morgan County Resident attending Indian Creek High School in Johnson County, with aspirations to participate in a post-secondary education program.

*Note: This is a reimbursement scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00. If selected as the recipient, you must turn in receipts for education expenses prior to receiving funds. **Funds will be dispersed after January 30, 2020, after receipt of qualifying receipts. All funds not dispersed prior to June 30, 2020 will revert to the Chamber Scholarship Fund.***

2. Application and essay must be typed or legibly printed in blue or black ink.
3. Please complete and submit the original application and required attachments, assembled in the following order:
 - A. Scholarship Application (3 pages)
 - B. Copy of your Cumulative High School Grade Transcript
 - C. Essay (2 pages)
 - D. Two letters of recommendation from non-relatives
 - One from an educator
 - One from a person in your community
