Judicial Campus

- \$72 million, several-phase project
- \$45 million building adjacent to Administration Building
 - 71,800 square feet over three floors
 - Many conference rooms
 - New parking areas for approx.
 240 vehicles
- Existing courthouse will be remodeled for administrative offices





Morgan County Courts

- Will house:
 - 3 Superior Courts
 - 1 Circuit Court
 - 2 Hearing Courts
 - Clerk and court services
- Entrance for court defendants
- Secure corridors
- Universal accessibility

Groundbreaking – May 15, 2023








Water Study

- INTERA hired to conduct the study
- Installation of real-time groundwater level monitoring devices
- Aims to understand the current status of water resources
- Helps ensure sustainable growth and development.
- Focuses on planning instead of regulating water use





Study Volunteers Needed

- Install sensors to wells across Morgan County to create real-time data network
- Monitoring system uses next-generation acoustic sensor technology to measure water levels
- Sensor attaches to the top of the well cap and does not interfere with the function of the well
